KEY ERGONOMIC BASICS

Powerful lumbar and lower back support

Most users will benefit from a strong lumbar support feature. It promotes positive open posture and prevents slouching. This feature is especially important for users with lower back pain or sway back.

Broad back and shoulder support

Significant upper back and shoulder support is often appreciated by larger users.
